

FISCAL NOTE

HB 877 - SB 891

March 4, 2005

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the Commissioner of Environment and Conservation to promulgate rules for a specific radioactive material license and requires public notice, comment period and public hearing within 30 days for an application for specific radioactive material licenses. Authorizes filing of a community impact statement by an applicant.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures -	\$ 5,600 One-Time
	\$ 68,000 Recurring

Assumptions:

- Department of Environment and Conservation would require one new position.
- Estimated 600 public notices per year and an estimated 60 hearings annually.
