

FISCAL NOTE

HB 927 - SB 1436

February 25, 2005

SUMMARY OF BILL: Makes the construction of an unauthorized entrance onto a highway located in the state a Class B misdemeanor offense. Such offense shall be punishable by a \$500 fine. Additional fines of \$100 per day shall be levied after thirty (30) days of non-compliance.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:


Increase State Revenues – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- The impact of this bill on state government is dependent upon the number of unauthorized entrances constructed and the resulting number of fines levied.
- The number of unauthorized entrances constructed onto a highway located in the state in any given year is estimated to be not significant.
- Estimated increase in state revenues is estimated to be not significant.
