

FISCAL NOTE

HB 990 - SB 1173

February 16, 2005

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prevents local education agencies (LEAs) from requiring World War I, World War II, or Korean War veterans or the immediate family of such deceased veterans to be current residents of the state at the time of requesting issuance of a high school diploma if the diploma was not received due to the interruption of education by military service.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumption:

- Many of the veterans eligible to receive a high school diploma have already received one. Therefore, any increase in expenditures for mailing such diploma to any veteran or family member who lives out-of-state is estimated to be not significant and can be handled within existing budgetary resources.
