

FISCAL NOTE

HB 1711 - SB 2011

March 14, 2005

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires pawnbrokers to obtain thumbprints from pledgors and retain the prints for five years. Currently, only Shelby and Knox Counties require pawnbrokers to obtain thumbprints. Additionally, the bill would allow law enforcement officers to submit affidavits for the thumbprints to magistrates rather than judges of a court of record or a general session's judge.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

MINIMAL

Assumption:

- Authorizing magistrates to receive affidavits would not result in additional expenditures for local governments.
