

FISCAL NOTE

HB 2081 - SB 2079

March 29, 2005

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Comptroller of the Treasury to report to the TennCare Oversight Committee on the effect of reductions in the TennCare waiver population. States the legislative intent that no hospital providers are required to contract with a specific managed care organization in order to receive supplemental payments. Requires any proposed waiver, waiver amendment or MCO contract to be submitted to the TennCare Oversight Committee for review.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:


Increase State Expenditures – Exceeds \$150,000 / One-Time
