

## **FISCAL NOTE**

### **HB 2757 - SB 3007**

March 18, 2006

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Exempts services and facilities that provide home-based assistance to individuals with mental or physical impairments. An individual of a home-based assistance facility that administers prescription medication to mentally or physically impaired individuals are exempted from nursing licensure.

#### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

##### **Decrease State Revenues – Exceeds \$100,000**

Assumption:

- Providers offering personal support services would no longer comply with any license standards. 120 licensees which provide personal support services only would cease to seek an \$810 licensure which will reduce state revenues by \$97,200. 159 licensees which provide personal support services and additional services would cease to seek a \$210 licensure which will reduce state revenues by \$33,390.
