

FISCAL NOTE

HB 2895 - SB 3320

March 13, 2006

SUMMARY OF BILL: Exempts properties owned by the state from having to upgrade their utility equipment when such property is transferred to a municipality or utility district.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- There will be a decrease in state expenditures for any administrative cost that the state would have incurred in association with the procurement of goods and services to make upgrades to such property in the absence of this bill.
- Any decrease in state expenditures will be not significant since any work that is not done will be accounted for when municipalities or utility districts agree with the state on a purchase price for such property.
