

# **FISCAL NOTE**

## **HB 2900 - SB 2907**

March 3, 2006

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires all election officials in metropolitan areas having more than 100,000 registered voters to receive job specific training as to their duties during an election; prohibits any election official from performing duties at the polling place on election day unless such person has completed the required training.

### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant**

**Increase Local Govt. Expenditures – Not Significant**

Assumptions:

- Any cost to the Coordinator of Elections to provide standardized instructional material for training of election officials and alternates is estimated to be not significant.
- Any cost to provide job specific training and certificates to persons serving as election officials in certain counties is estimated to be not significant and can be handled within the existing budgeted resources of the county election commission.
