

FISCAL NOTE

HB 2928 - SB 3190

March 17, 2006

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires all municipal, county and state employed plumbing and mechanical inspectors be certified by the State Fire Marshal.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Revenues - \$15,750 Triennially
Increase State Expenditures - \$5,400 One-Time

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures* - Exceeds \$75,000 Triennially

Assumptions:

- Approximately 350 persons will receive certification.
- An increase in state revenues from the collection of certification fees.
- A one-time increase in state expenditures for computer system changes.
- An increase in local government expenditures to pay for required training courses, continuing education and state certification.
- The state does not employ persons who perform mechanical and plumbing inspections.

*Article II, Section 24 of the Tennessee Constitution provides that: *no law of general application shall impose increased expenditure requirements on cities or counties unless the General Assembly shall provide that the state share in the cost.*
