

FISCAL NOTE

HB 2955 - SB 3116

February 26, 2006

SUMMARY OF BILL: Removes the requirement that DUI offenders sentenced to perform litter removal must do so at days and times that the offender is not working and will not interfere with such offender's regular employment.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease Local Govt. Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumption:

- Removal of this regulation may result in some savings to local governments by making scheduling litter pickup patrols easier and reducing overtime costs for local law enforcement for weekend litter pickup. Such a decrease is not estimated to be significant.
