

FISCAL NOTE

HB 3151 - SB 3055

March 10, 2006

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the Board of Probation and Paroles (BOPP) to establish a pilot project in any county in the state to assist ex-offenders in their re-entry to society. Authorizes BOPP to seek funding through a federal grant.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$45,800


Other Fiscal Impact - If federal grant funding is obtained, federal rather than state expenditures would fund this program to the extent of the grant. Federal grant funding is not mandatory, and BOPP is authorized to implement the program if federal funding is not obtained.

Assumption:

- BOPP would require one additional position, at a cost of \$45,800 for salary, benefits, and supplies, to implement the pilot program.
