HB 3203 - SB 3443

SUMMARY OF BILL: Defines “surgical technologist” and requires individuals employed as surgical technologists maintain current national certification and complete a program for surgical technology accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumption:

- The Department of Health will not incur a significant increase in state expenditures to amend the hospital ambulatory surgical treatment center regulations. Such an increase can be absorbed within existing resources.
