

## **FISCAL NOTE**

### **HB 3960 - SB 3978**

March 24, 2006

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Creates a Class C misdemeanor subject to a fine of not more than \$50 in addition to any other sanctions the Board of Medical Examiners may impose on anyone convicted of violating the provisions of state statute regarding health care referrals.

#### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

##### **Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant**

Assumptions:

- The Board of Medical Examiners is authorized to discipline applicants and licensees for violation or attempted violation of any provisions. Any increase in expenditures for providing information about this change will not be significant and can be absorbed within existing resources.
- There will not be a sufficient number of prosecutions for local governments to experience any significant increase in revenues or expenses.
