SUMMARY OF BILL: Permits local governments to regulate the use of tobacco products.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures– Less than \$100,000 / Permissive

Increase Local Govt. Revenues –Less than \$100,000 / Permissive

Assumptions:

- Local governments choosing to regulate the use of tobacco would experience costs by providing the necessary regulatory, judicial, and enforcement resources to implement such regulation.
- An increase in local government revenues from fines levied and collected for violations of ordinances regulating the use of tobacco. The maximum fine for an offense would be \$50.
