

# FISCAL NOTE

## SB 611 - HB 1994

February 23, 2005

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Increases the size of the Air Pollution Control Board from 14 to 15 members, the Solid Waste Disposal Control Board from 11 to 12 members, the Petroleum Underground Storage Board to from nine to 10 members, and the Water Quality Board from 10 to 11 members. Requires that each new member be appointed from a list of three names submitted by the Tennessee Conservation Voters.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Expenditures - \$9,800**

Assumptions:

- Department of Environment and Conservation will reimburse four additional members for travel expenses to Nashville.
- Each board member receives \$50 per diem.
- Air Pollution Control Board, Petroleum Underground Storage Board and Water Quality Board meet every month. The Solid Waste Disposal Control Board meets every other month.
- All boards meet in Nashville. New board members may not live in Nashville and may require hotel and travel expenses.
