

FISCAL NOTE

SB 703 - HB 952

March 6, 2005

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires that a hearing must be held within ten days of any order of protection if a petitioner is awarded temporary possession of the residence. At the hearing the court shall either dissolve the order awarding possession or shall extend the order for a period of time not to exceed one year. Currently, such hearings are held within 15 days.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

MINIMAL

Assumption:

- Requiring the hearing to be held five days earlier will have minimal fiscal impact.
