

FISCAL NOTE

SB 760 - HB 1280

February 12, 2005

SUMMARY OF BILL: Excludes birth certificates from public records and limits those who may request copies of birth certificates. Persons requesting a copy of a birth certificate must provide proof of identity.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease State Revenues - \$8,400

Decrease State Expenditures - Not Significant

Assumptions:

- The Office of Vital Records will cease issuing Verifications of Birth to the public.
- The elimination of disclosure of birth information to the public is estimated to eliminate annual sale of 700 birth verifications at \$12 each.
- The decrease in state expenditures from not producing a copy of birth information would be not significant.
