

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1356 - HB 1297

March 17, 2005

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes students enrolled in private, non-public, church-related, or home schools to participate in extra-curricular activities sponsored or engaged in by public schools upon meeting certain conditions.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- Such extra-curricula activities are already in existence in the LEAs and staffed with supervisory personnel.
- If the extra-curricula activity has a cap on the number of students allowed to participate, each non-public student would have equal access to the space with no increased fiscal responsibility.
- If the extra-curricula activity has no cap on participation, for example, in areas like theater or arts, there could be a cost for books, supplies and travel. However, the cost to LEAs to provide these items is estimated to be not significant.
