

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1513 - HB 1396

February 25, 2005

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a Class A misdemeanor offense for interfering with the safe operation of any motorboat or vessel in a reckless or negligent manner so as to endanger the life, limb, or property of any person.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Revenues – Not Significant/Wildlife Resources Fund

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures – Not Significant


Increase Local Govt. Revenues – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- There would be a small number of convictions for violations.
- The amount of fines collected will not be significant.
- There will not be a sufficient number of prosecutions for local governments to experience any significant increase in revenues or expenditures.
