

# FISCAL NOTE

## SB 1514 - HB 1345

March 23, 2005

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Increases the minimum penalty that may be imposed by the Health Services and Development Agency from \$100 to \$200 per day against any person who performs any activity for which a certificate of need is required without having first obtained a certificate of need.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Revenues – Not Significant**  
**Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant**

Assumption:

- Violators tend to cease and desist as directed by the Health Services and Development Agency before penalties are imposed.
- This bill would not have a significant impact on state revenues or expenditures since such civil penalties are rarely imposed.
