

## **FISCAL NOTE**

### **SB 2805 - HB 3101**

March 9, 2006

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Adds exemptions for Giles, Hickman, Houston, Humphreys, Lawrence, Lewis, Maury, Perry and Wayne Counties to the counties currently exempted from regulation by the Private Probation Services Council (PPSC) of providers of private probation supervisory services for misdemeanor offenders.

#### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

##### **Decrease State Expenditures – Not Significant**

Assumptions:

- By law, PPSC is self-funded. Any reduction in fees from providers of services in newly exempted counties will be offset by additional fees imposed on remaining registrants to the extent necessary to fund operations.
- A not significant net reduction in state expenditures from reduced workload resulting from services in fewer counties being subject to regulation.
