

## **FISCAL NOTE**

### **SB 2901 - HB 3169**

March 30, 2006

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Increases the percentage of nonresidents permitted to attend a state or community college without paying tuition from three percent (3%) to four percent (4%) of an institution's full-time student population.

#### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**


##### **Decrease State Revenues – Not Significant**

Assumption:

- In determining the amount of state appropriation needed for higher education, the higher education funding formula no longer reduces the recommended state appropriation by the out-of-state tuition revenue received by the various higher education institutions. Therefore, there would be no significant loss of revenue associated with increasing the percentage of out-of-state students to student population.
