

## **FISCAL NOTE**

### **SB 3157 - HB 3637**

March 10, 2006

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes persons who voluntarily seek mental health treatment as in-patients to apply for a handgun carry permit as long as they are otherwise qualified.

#### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase State Revenues – Not Significant**  
**Increase State Expenditures – \$6,000 One-Time**

Assumptions:

- According to the Department of Safety, any additional revenue generated from the issuance of additional handgun carry permits would be not significant.
- The handgun carry permit applications would need to be reprinted to reflect the qualification changes required by this bill. Approximately 50,000 permit applications currently in stock would be replaced at a cost of \$0.12 each (50,000 x 0.12).
- No additional resources will be required by the Tennessee Bureau of Investigations.
