

FISCAL NOTE

SB 3376 - HB 3407

March 27, 2006

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a legal representative of an estate of a victim, or if an estate is not opened, a relative of a victim to file for reimbursement of allowable funeral and burial expenses from the Criminal Injuries Compensation Fund (CIC Fund).

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant / Criminal Injuries Fund

Assumptions:

- The State Treasurer estimates that there may be an increase in claim payments for those filing now that did not previously know they were permitted to do so.
- As a practical matter, a “relative” of a victim has been considered an eligible claimant for allowable funeral and burial reimbursements.
