

FISCAL NOTE

SB 3893 - HB 4009

SUMMARY OF BILL: Establishes the “Tennessee Comprehensive Health Insurance Pool Planning Act of 2006” which creates a planning board to develop an operational and funding plan that details the steps to create and finance an insurance plan for individuals who are uninsurable or underinsured.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- Any increase in expenditures for the travel reimbursements for board members will be not significant and will be absorbed within existing resources of the Office of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration.
- Staff assistance provided by the Department of Finance and Administration and the Department of Commerce and Insurance will not have a significant increase on state expenditures and can be absorbed within existing resources of each department.
