

FISCAL NOTE

SJR 799

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Select Committee on Children and Youth to study the children's mental health system, develop recommendations for its improvement, and produce a report setting forth the master plan for development, implementation, and continuous oversight of a system for mental and behavioral health care. Authorizes the Committee to establish a study committee to obtain consultation and receive advisement in such effort.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- The Select Committee on Children and Youth will study the children's mental health system within the Committee's regular meeting schedule.
- There will not be a significant increase in expenditures for the Committee to consult with persons from appropriate departments and agencies.
- There will not be a significant increase in expenditures to produce a report for the development, implementation and oversight of a system for mental and behavioral health care.
