AMEND Senate Bill No. 442

House Bill No. 121*

by deleting subsection (b) of Section 63-10-214 of the amendatory language of Section 1 and by substituting instead the following:

(b) A pharmacist may not interchange an anti-epileptic drug or formulation of an anti-epileptic drug, brand or generic, for the treatment of epilepsy without prior notification of and the documented consent of such interchange from the prescribing physician, or physician assistant or nurse practitioner, and the patient, or patient's parent, legal guardian or spouse of such person. A violation of the provisions of this section is not a misdemeanor, but subjects the violator to any other sanction available under the provisions of this chapter.

AND FURTHER AMEND by deleting the language "informed consent" and by substituting instead the language "documented consent" in the amendatory language of Section 2.
