AMEND Senate Bill No. 652*

House Bill No. 1382

By deleting SECTION 1 of the printed bill in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-6-104, is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

Section 55-6-104.

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b), the county clerks, as deputies to the registrar of motor vehicles, shall, upon the performance of such duties as the registrar may prescribe under the laws governing the titling and licensing of vehicles and upon complying with the requirements of this chapter, be entitled to the following fees from applicants for the following services:

(1) For issuing certificates of registration and registration plates, for transferring registration plates from one motor vehicle to another and issuing a certificate therefor, for accepting for surrender certificates of registration and registration plates, for each set of registration plates and certificates of registration, the sum of three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50);

(2) For issuing replacement certificates of registration, the sum of two dollars (\$2.00) each;

(3) For receiving and forwarding to the division each application for certificates of title, including all acknowledgments of signatures thereunder, the sum of six dollars and fifty cents (\$6.50). Seventy-five cents (75¢) of such six dollar and fifty cent (\$6.50) fee shall be remitted to the state treasurer and credited to the general fund of the state;

(4) For issuing a duplicate certificate of ownership to replace a lost or destroyed certificate, the sum of six dollars and fifty cents (\$6.50). Seventy-five

cents (75¢) of this six dollar and fifty cent (\$6.50) fee shall be remitted to the state treasurer and credited to the general fund of the state; and

(5) For each transaction where sales tax is collected five dollars (\$5.00); except that the fee shall be six dollars (\$6.00) where sales tax is collected on the isolated sale of boats and other such vessels.

(b) In counties having a population of more than 897,000 according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent census, the county clerks, as deputies to the registrar of motor vehicles, shall, upon the performance of such duties as the registrar may prescribe under the laws governing the titling and licensing of vehicles and upon complying with the requirements of this chapter, be entitled to the following fees from applicants for the following services:

(1) For issuing certificates of registration and registration plates, for transferring registration plates from one motor vehicle to another and issuing a certificate therefor, for accepting for surrender certificates of registration and registration plates, for each set of registration plates and certificates of registration, the sum of two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50);

(2) For issuing replacement certificates of registration, the sum of fifty cents (50¢) each;

(3) For receiving and forwarding to the division each application for certificates of title, including all acknowledgments of signatures thereunder, the sum of five dollars and fifty cents (\$5.50). Fifty cents (50¢) of such five dollar and fifty cent (\$5.50) fee shall be remitted to the state treasurer and credited to the general fund of the state;

(4) For issuing a duplicate certificate of ownership to replace a lost or destroyed certificate, the sum of five dollars and fifty cents (\$5.50). Fifty cents (50¢) of this five dollar and fifty cent (\$5.50) fee shall be remitted to the state treasurer and credited to the general fund of the state; and

(5) For each transaction where sales tax is collected one dollar (\$1.00);
except that the fee shall be two dollars (\$2.00) where sales tax is collected on the
isolated sale of boats and other such vessels.
