

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 770

A RESOLUTION to confirm appointment of Tré Hargett of Oak Ridge, Tennessee as a director of the Tennessee regulatory authority.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101, creates the Tennessee regulatory authority as a separate and independent agency with jurisdiction over certain utility services, including telecommunications; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101, designates the speaker of the senate as sole appointing authority for one of the Tennessee regulatory authority's four (4) directorships; and

WHEREAS, The speaker of the senate has appointed Tré Hargett of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, to serve as an interim director of the authority for the balance of the unexpired term recently vacated by the resignation of Pat Miller of Nashville: such interim term of service to commence on February 8, 2008, and expire on June 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, The speaker of the senate has also appointed Tré Hargett to additionally serve as a director of the authority for a full six-year term: such six-year term of service to commence on July 1, 2008, and expire on June 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101, requires such appointments to be confirmed by joint resolution adopted by each house; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, That each house hereby confirms the senate speaker's appointment of Tré Hargett of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, to serve as an interim director of the Tennessee regulatory authority for the balance of the unexpired term recently vacated by the resignation of Pat Miller

of Nashville: such interim term of service to commence on February 8, 2008, and expire on June 30, 2008; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That each house hereby also confirms the senate speaker's appointment of Tré Hargett to serve as a director of the Tennessee regulatory authority for a full six-year term: such six-year term of service to commence on July 1, 2008 and expire on June 30, 2014.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the clerk of the house of representatives is directed to deliver copies of this resolution to the Tennessee regulatory authority and to the secretary of state.
