

**PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 251**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 50, Part 5, relative to suspension and revocation of driver licenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-50-504(a)(1), is amended by adding the following language to the end thereto:

Convictions occurring more than ten (10) years prior to the immediate violation shall not be considered for enhancement purposes under this subdivision, provided, however, the department shall abide by all federal rules and regulations relative to the issuance, suspension, and revocation of driver licenses and qualification of drivers.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-50-504(a)(2), is amended by adding the following language between the first and second sentence of such subdivision:

Convictions occurring more than ten (10) years prior to the immediate violation shall not be considered for enhancement purposes under this subdivision, provided, however, the department shall abide by all federal rules and regulations relative to the issuance, suspension, and revocation of driver licenses and qualification of drivers.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2007, the public welfare requiring it.
