

**FISCAL MEMORANDUM
HB 4184 – SB 4116**

March 31, 2008

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (015957): Deletes the original bill in its entirety. Requires the Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) to report to the Senate Environment, Conservation and Tourism Committee and the House Conservation and Environment Committee by January 31st of each year certain information concerning enforcement orders, directors' orders, Commissioner's orders, final orders, consent orders, complaints, permit applications, the length of time between receiving a permit application and notification that the application is complete, the length of time between the date of application for permit and the grant or denial of such permit, and the status of the implementation of a secure web portal for the submittal of online permit applications.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Expenditures - \$650,000/One-Time
\$250,000/Recurring

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumption applied to amendment:

- Any increase in state expenditures for TDEC to submit the required information is estimated to be not significant and can be handled within existing resources without an increased appropriation or reduced reversion.
