

FISCAL NOTE

HB 1197 - SB 1678

March 12, 2007

SUMMARY OF BILL: Exempts a Certified Radiology Practitioner Assistant who holds an active certification from the Board for Radiology Practitioner Assistants and the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists prior to July 1, 2007 from having a baccalaureate degree.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant
Increase State Revenues – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- The bill could increase the applications for certification as a radiologist assistant.
- The Board of Medical Examiners will not incur a significant increase in expenditures for an increase in applications.
- All Health Related Boards, by statute, are self-supporting such that revenues equal expenditures.
