

FISCAL NOTE

HB 2302 - SB 2283

April 2, 2007

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires organ donations in hospitals be requested by a hospital employee trained or designated by an organ procurement agency as a qualified requestor. Requires the organ procurement agency to complete a tissue and organ request form. Creates a Class B misdemeanor for failing to adhere to the requirements for tissue and organ procurement.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures – Not Significant

Increase Local Govt. Revenues – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- The Department of Health will not incur a significant increase in state expenditures to regulate the revised provisions for tissue and organ donations.
- Local governments will not incur a significant increase in expenditures or revenues for the creation of a Class B misdemeanor.
