

# FISCAL NOTE

## HB 2459 - SB 2607

January 30, 2008

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes the issuance of a special license plate for members of the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary. Authorizes the issuance of “emergency” plates to members of the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase State Revenue - \$2,800/One-Time**  
**Increase State Expenditures - \$2,800/One-Time**

Assumptions:

- There are approximately 220 members of the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary in Tennessee.
- According to the provisions of the bill, the special plate will be issued with the payment of the regular registration fee and a fee set in an amount to cover the one-time costs of designing and manufacturing the plate so that the issuance of the plate will be revenue neutral. (220 plates @ \$3.76 each = \$827.20 + \$2,000 computer system changes = \$2,827.20).
- No difference in the cost of an “emergency” license plate versus a regular license plate.
