

# FISCAL NOTE

## HB 2972 - SB 3409

January 31, 2008

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires local education agencies (LEAs) to submit an annual personnel report to the Department of Education.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

**Increase Local Gov't. Expenditures\* - \$62,500**

Assumption:

- According to the Comptroller, many schools could perform this work within existing resources. However, approximately 5 counties with large numbers of non-certified employees would require one additional part-time staff person for six months to compile the data. Assume an average six month salary of \$12,500. The cost for 5 counties to hire one temporary staff person would be \$62,500 ( $\$12,500 \times 5 = \$62,500$ ).

\*Article II, Section 24 of the Tennessee Constitution provides that: *no law of general application shall impose increased expenditure requirements on cities or counties unless the General Assembly shall provide that the state share in the cost.*
