

## **FISCAL NOTE**

### **HB 4195 - SB 4193**

March 6, 2008

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Decreases the number of years in which a patient's records must be kept after his or her services are terminated at a regional mental health institute or developmental center from 10 to five. Increases the membership of the board of trustees at each facility from 15 to 19 members. Reduces the number of days a court must hold a commitment hearing from 20 to 15. Removes the court's authority to determine the place of a commitment hearing and exclude the public from the hearing.

#### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**


##### **Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant**
