

FISCAL NOTE

SB 482 - HB 1632

February 19, 2007

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits an anesthesiologist from restricting the rights of an employed anesthesiologist to practice medicine upon the termination of the employment relationship except under certain circumstances.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant
Increase State Revenues – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- The Board of Medical Examiners would investigate any complaints that were filed due to the provisions of the proposed legislation.
- The Board of Medical Examiners, by statute, is self supporting such that revenues equal expenditures.
