

FISCAL NOTE

SB 493 - HB 1147

March 6, 2007

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Great Smoky Mountain Park Commission to meet every four months instead of every six months. Requires the Conservation Commission to report to the Senate Environment, Conservation and Tourism Committee and the House Conservation and Environment Committee about the programs and activities of the commission by February 15, 2008.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- The Great Smoky Mountain Park Commission will meet the same number of times per year. The only change will be when such meetings are scheduled.
- Any increase in state expenditures due to the administrative cost of requiring the Conservation Commission to provide the required report is estimated to be not significant.
