

FISCAL NOTE

SB 712 - HB 1323

February 21, 2007

SUMMARY OF BILL: Includes independent contractors and subcontractors in the definition of “employee” in regard to the employment records in alimony and child support cases.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Other Fiscal Impact – Increase Federal Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumptions:

- There will not be a significant increase to the operating cost of the Child Support Enforcement program. Any increase will be absorbed within the existing resources of the Department of Human Services.
- The Child Support Enforcement program is funded through both state (34%) and federal (66%) funds.
- There will be an increase in child support collections which will not have a fiscal impact on the expenditures or revenues of the Department of Human Services.
