

FISCAL NOTE

SB 803 - HB 1508

February 18, 2007

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the legislative body of a local government to adopt by 2/3 vote, either a resolution or ordinance that provides an appeal process for the judgments of the local historic zoning commission. Currently, such appeals are handled by the courts through the process of statutory certiorari. Any local government that does not adopt such resolution or ordinance will continue to hear appeals through the court system.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumption:

- There will be an increase in local government expenditures for local legislative bodies to hear such appeals. The increase in expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
