

# CORRECTED FISCAL NOTE

## SB 816 - HB 2055

March 6, 2007

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Exempts Claiborne County from charging and collecting \$60.00 of the \$62.50 marriage license fee if both of the applicants are not Tennessee residents.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

On February 26, 2007 we issued a fiscal note on this bill that indicated a *decrease in state revenues of less than \$10,000 and a decrease in local government revenues of less than \$1,000*. According to the provisions of the bill and current law, local governments will still retain the \$2.50 fee that they currently collect. As a result, the estimated fiscal impact of this bill is:

#### Decrease State Revenues – Less than \$10,000/Earmarked as follows:

Department of Children's Services	25.00%
Department of Education	6.67%
AOC-Divorcing Parents Fund	11.67%
Office of Criminal Justice – F&A	12.50%
Tennessee Disability Coalition	34.17%
Tennessee CASA	5.00%
National Assoc. of Social Workers	5.00%

#### Assumptions:

- Claiborne County issues 300-400 licenses per year.
- Approximately half of the licenses would qualify for the exemption provided by the bill.
- County Clerks will still collect \$2.50 per license.
- The state receives \$60.00 per license.
