

FISCAL NOTE

SB 1439 - HB 1359

March 6, 2007

SUMMARY OF BILL: Exempts any guardian ad litem appointed by the court from any liability while acting within the scope of such appointment unless the guardian ad litem has a conflict of interest with the case which was not disclosed. Any guardian ad litem with a conflict of interest shall request the court to appoint a new guardian ad litem.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – Not Significant

Increase Local Govt. Expenditures – Not Significant

Assumption:

- There will not be a significant increase in the caseloads of the state and local court systems. Any increase in expenditures will be absorbed within existing state and local expenditures.
