

# **FISCAL NOTE**

## **SB 1896**

February 14, 2007

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Increases from 10 days to 20 days the amount of time after receiving a written application and applicable fee to drill a mineral test hole that a representative of the Department of Environment and Conservation has to issue or deny a permit.

### **ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

#### **MINIMAL**

Assumption:

- Such an increase in the time frame within which to issue a permit will have no fiscal impact on state or local government revenues or expenditures.
