

FISCAL NOTE

SB 2989 – HB 4160

SUMMARY OF BILL: Exempts certain employers and employees from providing or receiving workers' compensation benefits in cases where the acceptance of such benefits would violate religious beliefs of the employees.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

MINIMAL

Assumption:

- Under current law individuals can choose to file or not file a workers' compensation claim. It is assumed that the individuals impacted by this bill would choose not to file a claim if doing so violated their religious beliefs.
