

FISCAL NOTE

SB 3711 - HB 4048

February 28, 2008

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases the period of denial for driver's license or driver's permit due to withdrawal from secondary school from 18 to 21 years of age with certain exceptions.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease State Revenue – Not Significant
Increase State Expenditures - \$10,500/One-Time

Assumptions:

- According to the Department of Safety (DOS), the number of additional denials is estimated to be not significant. As a result, any decrease of state revenue attributable to fewer license and permit issuance fees is estimated to be not significant.
- DOS indicates that three computer programs will require modification at a cost of approximately \$3,500 each. Total one-time state expenditures are estimated to be \$10,500.
