SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a special joint committee to conduct a full review of the proprietary and career colleges. The committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the House and Senate Education Committees of the 105th General Assembly no later than January 1, 2008, at which time the committee shall cease to exist.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$2,300 Each One Day Meeting

Assumptions:

- Travel and per diem expenses for six legislative members of \$1,638 per meeting (\$153 per diem plus \$120 mileage each).
- Travel expenses for seven non-legislative members of \$644 per meeting (200 miles at \$0.46 x 7 members).
