

# FISCAL NOTE

## SJR 661

February 8, 2008

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Proposed constitutional amendment to provide for popular election of the Lieutenant Governor and Secretary of State and to hold a four-year term of office. The foregoing amendment shall be referred to the 106<sup>th</sup> General Assembly and this resolution proposing such amendment be published by the Secretary of State in accordance with Article XI, Section 3, of the Constitution of Tennessee.

### ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

#### Increase State Expenditures – \$20,000/One-Time

Assumptions:

- A one-time cost of \$20,000 to the Secretary of State to print notice of the proposed amendment in certain newspapers as required by this resolution.
- Article XI, Section 3 of the Constitution requires publication of the resolution before the next legislative election. This publication would occur in the spring of 2008.
