AMEND Senate Bill No. 3586

House Bill No. 2875*

by adding the following new sections immediately preceding the last section and by renumbering the subsequent section accordingly:

SECTION __. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-110(a)(8), is amended by deleting the following language:

No state agency or any political subdivision of the state that installs, owns, operates, or maintains a traffic-control signal light in an intersection that employs a surveillance camera for the enforcement or monitoring of traffic violations shall reduce the time exposure of the yellow light at the intersection with the intended purpose of increasing the number of traffic violations.

SECTION __. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-198, is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

No state agency or political subdivision of the state shall install or maintain a red light surveillance camera or a speed surveillance camera for the purpose of:

(1) Recording a visual image of a motor vehicle being operated in violation of a traffic signal's red light directive to stop or of a posted speed limit; and

(2) Using such image to support a notice of a violation or a citation.

SECTION __. Any notice of a violation or citation for a violation of a traffic signal's red light directive to stop or of a posted speed limit that is supported only by a visual image taken by a red light or speed surveillance camera shall be enforceable against the violator if the violation occurred prior to January 1, 2011. Any notice of a violation or citation sent for a violation of a traffic signal's red light directive to stop or of a posted speed limit that is supported only by a visual image taken by a red light or speed surveillance camera shall not be enforceable against the violator if the violation occurred on or after January 1, 2011.
