

HOUSE BILL 3778

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2 and  
Title 3, relative to the general assembly.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 3-13-104, is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

Section 3-13-104.

(a) The director of legislative administration shall cause to be posted on the official general assembly web site a report, by member, that contains the per diem payments made to members of the general assembly and all other expenses, including out-of-state travel, reimbursed in accordance with the provisions of § 3-1-106. The report shall include the purpose of the reimbursement made. The initial report shall be filed no later than fifteen (15) days following the last day of April 2006, and shall include all payments made from the first day of January 2006, until the last day of March 2006. Thereafter, the report shall be updated quarterly, no later than fifteen (15) days following the end of the quarter. The reports shall remain on the web site until one month following the end of each general assembly. The last quarter reported in each general assembly shall include the period of time from the last quarter reported until the regular November election and the first report in each general assembly shall include the period of time from the regular November election until the end of the first quarter.

(b) The director of legislative administration, in consultation with the director of legislative information services, shall cause to be posted on the official

general assembly web site individual district maps for each senate and representative district of the general assembly. Each district map shall include the name of the member who represents the district and a link to the member's web page on the official web site. Such maps shall contain sufficient detail to readily identify the boundaries of each individual district and may include other features including major highways, major cities and major waterways.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
