

SENATE BILL 3563

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 15, Part 4; Title 57, Chapter 3; Title 57, Chapter 4 and Title 57, Chapter 5, relative to sales of alcoholic beverages and beer to persons under 21 years of age.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-406(d), is amended by adding the following language at the end of the subsection:

A retailer committing a violation of this subsection (d) shall pay a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) in addition to any other penalty prescribed by law.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-203(b)(1)(A), is amended by adding the following language at the end of the subdivision:

A licensee committing a violation of this subdivision (b)(1)(A) shall pay a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) in addition to any other penalty prescribed by this subdivision (A).

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-5-301(a)(2), is amended by adding the following language at the end of the subdivision:

A permit holder committing a violation of subdivision (a)(1) shall pay a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500) in addition to any other penalty prescribed by this subdivision (a)(2).

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010, the public welfare requiring it.
